Here's why...



healthy life is something we all want for ourselves. Most of us can access healthy living resources in our community, but for some of our neighbors who have disabilities, the cost and challenges of getting fit and keeping in shape are beyond their reach. The **Spirit Club Foundation**, based in Kensington, MD, provides scholarships for persons who have a disability to access customized exercise and fitness classes and programs. Scholarships are provided to individuals with physical disabilities, persons with intellectual and/or developmental disabilities and to persons living with aging-related memory loss, as well as persons with mental health disorders.

In Maryland, a 2016 research study determined that persons with disabilities make up 21.6% of our state's population. According to Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, people with disabilities are 58% more likely to be obese than the general population. And a strong contributing factor is the lack of opportunity for people with disabilities to exercise, and a lack of funds to pay for programs.

The **Spirit Club Foundation** has an impressive track record in improving the health and fitness of persons with disabilities, one person at a time, and through partnerships with other nonprofits, county agencies and service providers. The Foundation is recognized as a leading advocate for healthy living for persons with disabilities with their programs in Washington, DC, Montgomery County, Prince George's County, Howard County and Baltimore City. And it is proud to be bringing a disability perspective to outreach efforts such as Healthy Montgomery and Health Matters Maryland.
